In 2021 Gattefossé continued its efforts to make its palm oil supply chain even more responsible. During 2021, we have 3 additional products (initially made with non-certified palm derivatives) that we have been able to upgrade to RSPO MB certification.

This operation required Gattefossé to strongly motivate and train one of its subcontractors to become RSPO certified. The few references still active in 2021, not manufactured with certified derivatives should disappear from our catalog before the end of 2023.

Finally, there are still 2 references for which it is not economically possible to switch to RSPO certified.

We therefore hope to further improve our RSPO scoring for cosmetic products during 2022. The volumes reported for 2021 ACOP are linked to our Personal Care activities.

In 2021 almost all our personal care portfolio is certified RSPO. We expect the few old, non strategic products remaining to switch to RSPO certified grade during 2022 or 2023.
Never the less for these products the economical impact of the switch to MB grade may delay the switch (due to actual economical situation and low raw material price visibility).

Another challenge is also linked to the MB system, as customers have difficulties to understand or trust this system. The Resolution GA18-2c, Enhancing the robustness of the RSPO Mass Balance model, will certainly help to improve the adhesion to this model.
