As customers request a transition to RSPO certified materials, Voyant is partnering with them to achieve their objectives. We anticipate a transition to 100% RSPO certified products will be a natural/organic process as customers make the value decision. Currently, Voyant does not anticipate nor take the position of having to force a transition by customers, however, for the sake of process, storage and cost efficiencies within our operations, customers not requesting transition will ultimately be transitioned. We anticipate a transition to 100% certified material will not exceed a period of 10 years from certification.
