Dunkin' has many international franchisees/countries that source their own shortening/fry oil as independent business owners, and this is not managed directly by Dunkin'. As shared in prior updates, Dunkin' has been working with its international franchisees that source shortening on their own locally to transition to RSPO certified palm oil if they have not already. We have made significant progress in the past year with our international partners and continue to drive awareness and action on certified sustainable palm oil.
