Pure refined and unrefined palm kernel oil: Purchase 100 per cent at least at mass balance from 1 January 2016. Purchase 100 per cent segregated from 1 January 2018. Fractions and derivatives (irrespective of whether palm oil or palm kernel oil based): Purchase 100 per cent at least mass balance since 2020. For the remaining shares of fractions and derivatives, which are not covered by the supply chain option mass balancing, book & claim certificates will still have to be purchased by the store brand suppliers. In this stance, the supply chain option book & claim should only be considered a transitional solution. The certificates still required should be purchased from selected, responsible palm oil producers in the context of so-called off-market deals, if possible.

supply chain. However, given the current structure of value chains, the socio-economic settings in sourcing countries and the design of certification bodies and standards, human rights violations still occur. This poses challenges both to the credibility of the standard as well as collective sustainability efforts. Thus, an improvement and even stricter application of RSPO principles is necessary to foster sustainable palm oil sourcing.
